

SEAS 3D PRINT CORE PROJECT REQUIREMENTS

- Projects must either be research related or must embody Harvard's mission. Harvard research related projects will be prioritized.
- Use of the core or core resources for production of commercial products or components is not allowed.
- Use of the core or resources for production of weapons or components for weapons are not allowed.
- Production volumes over 50 units need to be discussed with the core manager prior to job submission. Large production volumes may be rejected if core capacity cannot handle the volume.
- Affiliate users and external users must apply to use the core by filling out this intake form: https://harvard.az1.qualtrics.com/jfe/form/SV_4MDJ2T7cy9MHgIS
- If projects are found to be in violation of any of these requirements, they will be rejected and your access to the core will be re-evaluated.
- Projects intended to do, incite or serve as symbols of violence (outside of research purposes) are not permitted.
- The limited list above is not exhaustive. SEAS reserves the right to reject or discontinue any project at any time in its sole discretion.
