This letter is to inform you that I hereby transfer ownership of my telescope, camera, and dome to Harvard University. The telescope is an 10" F15 refractor and includes a 3" finder and a 3" Ross-Fecker Astrograph. The dome is 22 feet in diameter, of steel construction, and covered with copper.

I am naturally quite pleased to learn that the instruments and dome will be used on the new Science Center. I, of course, authorize the sale of this gift by the university at some later date if it becomes obsolete or is duplicated. I am also quite willing to leave the telescope and the dome in their present location in Ohio until Harvard is ready for them.
